

Dear New York Holstein Association Scholarship Applicant,

The New York Holstein Association will be awarding scholarships during the NY Junior Holstein Convention in January. Eligible candidates include high school seniors or full-time college freshmen, sophomores, or juniors at an accredited college. The selection of recipients is completed by the scholarship committee. Recipients may receive this scholarship more than one time. The application must be postmarked or emailed on or before **July 1**.

General Eligibility requirements include:

- Current active member in good standing of the NY Junior Holstein Association or if 21 years or older, a current Senior member in good standing.
- Individuals must be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing at an accredited two or four-year undergraduate program.
- Plans to pursue a career in the dairy industry or a dairy industry-related field.
- Academic achievement and involvement in dairy-related youth programs (Jr. Holstein, 4H, FFA) as well as school and community involvement.

Along with the completed application, also include the following:

- Two letters of recommendation
- School advisor's confidential evaluation
- Official transcript of grades for the most current completed semester

Please follow the application instructions. Additional, unnecessary information, extra references, or anything that does not follow the instructions will detract from the overall application score. Using this jotform, or submitting a typed application using at least a 12 font is highly recommended. Correct spelling, proper grammar, thoughtfulness, and care in preparation, as well as the content and accuracy, will be considered.

It is strongly encouraged that applicants verify that their application, confidential evaluation, two letters of recommendation, and official transcript have been received by emailing jdonnan@nyholsteins.com on or about July 1. Notification letters will be mailed to recipients and non-recipients in the fall. To receive the scholarship, winners are required to submit their fall semester transcript as proof of completion of a successful full-time semester and a digital photo before the convention.
