AWARD PROGRAM**

Open to NY Junior Holstein breeders. A Junior is considered any member under 21 years of age on January 1 in the year of the award.

Eligibility - Juniors must be Junior members of the and the New York State Junior Holstein Association. Animals for which the award entries are being made must be enrolled in official test and official classification.

Application for nominees for Junior "Star Breeder" award must be submitted to and approved by the New York State Holstein Association office. "Star Breeder" certificates will be awarded each year at the New York State Junior Holstein Association Annual Meeting. Juniors qualifying on a single animal will be designated a "1 Star Breeder"; on two animals a "2 Star Breeder"; etc.

Junior qualifying on **five individual animals will automatically be designated a New York State "Junior Progressive Breeder"**. The New York State "Junior Progressive Breeder" Award recognition will be in the form of a plaque presented at the Annual Meeting of the State Association.

Requirements

1. Animals must be bred by Junior member making application. The breeder of an animal will be determined as stated on the registration certificate. Current ownership of the animal is not required by the Junior member breeder making application.
2. Only the latest 305 day or less production record and current classification score will be considered. Completed record not required, but actual not mature equivalent, requirements by age must be met.
3. Animals must have been officially classified by the Holstein Association USA and have met or exceeded the requirements by age.

4. **All entries must be accompanied** by a copy of the DHIA cow page or a copy of the official DHIA herd test sheet which lists the cow's current record. A **photo copy** of the registration paper must accompany entries. Please do not send official registration papers.
5. Any individual animal may qualify her breeder for "Star Breeder" recognition only once.
6. For the 2017 awards, cows completing lactations after October 1, 2017 will be accepted as eligible entries. Deceased animals meeting this criteria are also eligible.
