Winners will be chosen for the highest milk, fat and protein production, based on actual records only, in the milking yearling, two, three, four, five-year old and over, and lifetime categories.

The rules for the contest are as follows:

1. Applicant must be a Junior member of the New York Junior Holstein Association and the Holstein Association U.S.A., Inc.
2. Animal must have been registered in the applicant's name prior to the start of the lactation. Partnership entries will be accepted only if all members of the partnership are active Junior members of the Association. Please include copy of registration paper.
3. Only DHI or DHIR records, 305 days will be accepted. (If this record is unavailable, please use the most recent figures just under 305 days.)
4. Eligible records are those with 305 days **completed** during the current Junior Holstein club year, October 1, 2016 - September 30, 2017.
5. All entries must be accompanied by a copy of DHI herd sheet and/or Individual Cow Page.
Please do not send original page as they will not be returned
6. Entries must be mailed to the NYHA Office by November 10th. Award winners will be notified in early December.
7. The lifetime records can be made prior to ownership of the animal by the Junior member. List the total number of days for the lifetime record.
8. Any 305-day lactation in excess of 30,000 pounds of milk will earn the 30,000 lb Cow Award. An animal may only qualify once.
9. Any lifetime record in excess of 75,000 pounds of milk will make the applicant a member of the "75,000 Pound Club" with an award.
10. Any lifetime record in excess of 100,000 pounds of milk will make the applicant a member of the "100,000 Pound Club" with an award.
11. Any lifetime record in excess of 150,000 pounds of milk will make the applicant a member of the "150,000 Pound Club" with an award.
12. Any lifetime record in excess of 200,000 pounds of milk will make the applicant a member of the "200,000 Pound Club" with an award.
13. An animal may qualify only once for the 75,000, 100,000 and 150,000 Pound Clubs. An animal may apply yearly for the 200,000 Pound Club award.
14. An animal may qualify only once for the Excellent Animal Bred and Owned by a Junior Member. A copy of the animal's registration certificate, showing the most recent classification score, must be submitted with this application. Partnerships will only be accepted if the partners were Jr. members at the time the cow was bred.
15. Cow must be at least 87% Registered Holstein Ancestry to be eligible for these awards.
16. Awards will be awarded at the New York State Junior Holstein Convention in January 2018.
